Patti Jo Lewis wakes up from ostomy surgery thinking her life is over. Then she meets Lorraine, a dynamic woman who is thriving after the same surgery and who demonstrates to Patti that maybe her life is only beginning.

Lorraine soon has trouble of her own, however, when her ex-husband dies violently under a cloud of mystery. Patti helps her new friend uncover the truth and is reunited with her high school boyfriend, Robb, now a police officer investigating the case.

Solving the mystery isn't the only challenge facing Patti. She needs to decide how far she can trust Robb while he is working on the case, possibly against Lorraine's interests. And with new resolve, Patti attempts to close rifts in her own family: between her estranged father and brother, and between all of them and her mother, who abandoned them for another man many years before.
